However, they can only recommend to the holders of the purse strings and any final outcome will depend on the pressure we ourselves put on the politicians. That was on Tuesday. Then on Thursday the clobbering machine hit us again with the announcement that Radio NZ was to be reorganised with the closure of the concert programme as we know and like, to be replaced with some continuous streamed unhosted nonsense on AM. I was delighted to see on Friday that Helen Clark commented that this continuous dumbing down of Library, Archive and radio services was a great disservice to the community. There was not much that Helen has agreed with me about, but on this issue she and I are in complete agreement. The price citizens must pay for democracy and the services that we wish to retain is continual pressure on politicians to retain these services. If we don't then lobbyists with more influence will succeed in chipping away at these long held services that have been specifically put in place over the past two hundred years throughout the western world in order that all of us may derive benefit from the 'Age Of Enlightenment' not just the wealthy few.

The AGM will be held on Tuesday 3rd March. Details for our proposed acceptance of full integration with Rebus have been circulated and annual report details will filter through as they come to hand.

I look forward to seeing you all at the AGM.
