ANSWERS TO QUERIES FROM THE AGM

Some queries about the wording of the new Constitution and Bylaws were raised. These were discussed by the committee this week and the following actions taken:

- 1 In the Constitution, the word "Rebus" has been added in a heading where it had been omitted.
- 2 In Bylaw 3a, dealing with the Management Committee, the word "shall" has been replaced in this sentence by "should": "The immediate Past President should be a member, ex officio, of the Committee".
- 3 In Bylaw 7b, dealing with Accounts, says: "Signatories of the account shall be the President, Vice president(s), Secretary, Treasurer and designated committee member(s). Any two signatories may operate the account jointly." A member asked if that left the possible numbers of signatories too open, but that wording has been in the old Bylaws for many years and we decided that "designated" was sufficient, given that a formal motion of the committee is needed to confirm the authorised names.
